Two hundred and fifty years ago, a man named Dr. Joseph Warren gave everything for the cause of American liberty. A Harvard-educated physician, revolutionary leader, and hero of the Battle of Bunker Hill, Warren's courage and sacrifice helped ignite the struggle for independence that gave birth to our nation.

Today, his story remains one of the most inspiring-yet least known-chapters in American history. The Dr. Joseph Warren Foundation, a volunteer-led organization, is dedicated to changing that. Our mission is to honor and celebrate Warren's legacy through education, public outreach, and now the creation of a sweeping documentary that will finally bring his story to the forefront of our shared national memory.



It was Warren's leadership and resistance activities that led directly to the Battles of Lexington and Concord and Bunker Hill—the very sparks that ignited the American Revolution.

At Bunker Hill, though appointed a Major General, Warren chose to fight as a volunteer soldier on the front lines. When his men began to retreat, he stayed behind, defending them until he was killed in action. He died so that his country might live. A widower, he left behind four orphaned children, ages two to ten.

Today, we ask you to honor his sacrifice by helping us preserve and share his legacy with future generations. Your contribution—no matter the amount—will directly support the production of the Dr. Joseph Warren Documentary Project, ensuring this founding patriot receives the recognition he so richly deserves.

A Legacy of Medicine and Military Service

Dr. Joseph Warren stood at the helm of an extraordinary medical and military dynasty. Generations of his descendants—Harvard-trained physicians and surgeons—helped to found Harvard Medical School and the New England Journal of Medicine. They went on to pioneer medical milestones such as the first successful operation with anesthesia and the first rhinoplasty in the United States. Today, Warren's medical lineage continues through his sixth great-granddaughter, a surgeon at the University of Virginia, who established the Dr. Joseph Warren Award at Baylor University in his honor.

Warren's military legacy is equally enduring. His descendants have served in every major American conflict from the Civil War to the present day. Generations of West Point graduates have selflessly served their country with honor and distinction. Warren himself may rightly be called the father of the United States Army: in May 1775, his letter to the Continental Congress urged the creation of a national army and the appointment of a "generalissimo." On June 14, 1775, Congress formally established the Continental Army and named George Washington its leader. That same day, Warren was commissioned Major General of the Provincial Army.

For more than a quarter of a millennium, Dr. Joseph Warren's legacy of courage, intellect, and service to country has endured.

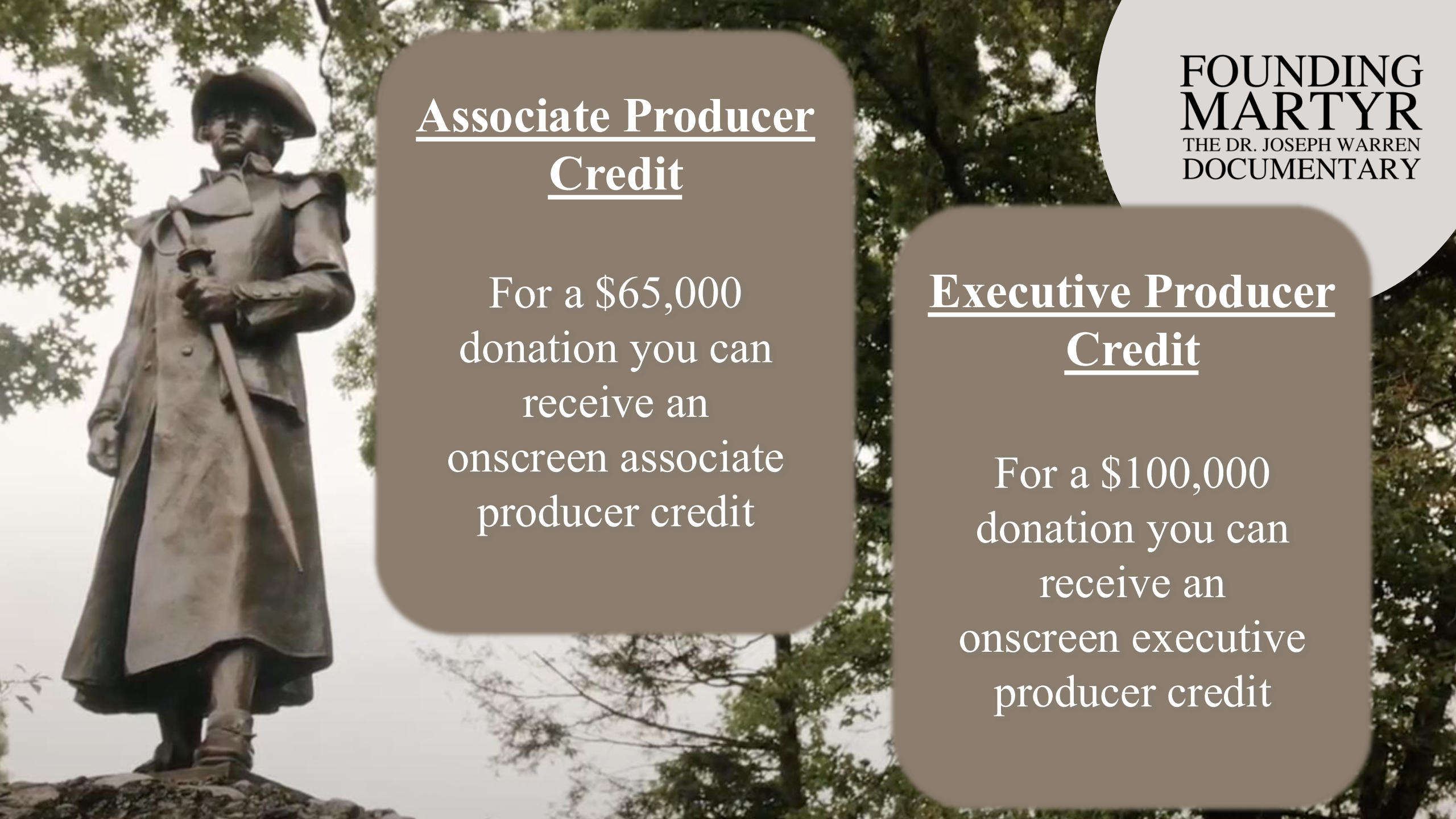


